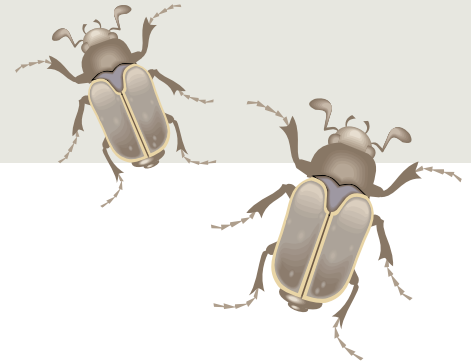
The Pesticide Applicators Workshop keeps both your knowledge and your license current. Under the Colorado Pesticide Applicators Act, to maintain your status as a Qualified Supervisor or a Certified Operator, you must accumulate seven Continuing Education Credits (CEC's) in core subjects and one/two CEC(s) in each of the categories in which you are currently licensed.

Approved by the Colorado Department of Agriculture, the Pesticide Applicators Workshop offers many of the CECs required to keep your license valid. In addition, this workshop can provide part of the verifiable training requirements for your non-licensed employees (technicians) in lieu of in-house training.

The ISA-RMC Pesticide Applicators Workshop was the first (starting in 1981) and remains the longest-running program which meets all the requirements for licensed applicators to maintain their Colorado license and avoid having to pay \$100 and retake the difficult test.

NOTE TO ISA CERTIFIED ARBORISTS

This program qualifies for ISA Continuing Education Credits (CEUs).
